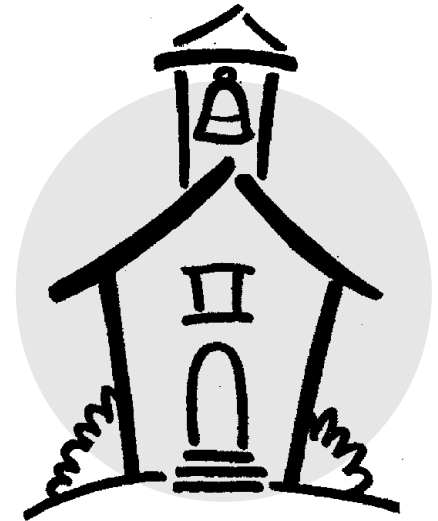


FBISD to use new process to develop school attendance zone for Elementary #40

FORT BEND ISD — The district's newest elementary school, located in Richmond at 4455 Waterside Estates Drive in the Waterside Estates subdivision, will open its doors for the 2006-07 school year. As part of a new district zoning process that will be used to develop an attendance zone for the campus, three Board Zoning Workshops/Community Forum meetings will be held.

The district will be using several methods to inform parents from these campuses and other interested community members about the upcoming zoning meetings.

The district's new zoning process was developed in response to a community survey on zoning that was conducted this past fall. The new zoning meeting format will provide for a combined Board Workshop and Community Forum that allows everyone to review the data and hear all comments and suggestions for developing the zone. After the workshop portion of the meeting, community members will have an opportunity to provide input.
