- 1.4.3 Direction: Racing is Anti-Clockwise.
- 1.4.4 Track Density: Practice, Qualify and Race as per the CAMS Track Licence.

1.5 ENTRIES

- 1.5.1 Open Date: 5th November 2007.
- 1.5.2 Closing Date: 11th January 2008.
 - 1.5.2.1 Due to the Closing of entries being part of the Christmas Holiday period we would like to endeavour to have entries by Friday 21st December, but will close entries as listed above.
- 1.5.3 Entry Fee: As agreed with the relevant Category Manager.
- 1.5.4 If the number of entries received exceeds the maximum number of competitors as per these regulations, the promoter/organiser in consultation with the relevant category manager reserves the right to accept those entries which it deems most suitable.
- 1.5.5 The promoter/organiser reserve the right to accept or reject entries at their sole discretion without assigning reason, in accordance with NCR 84.
- 1.5.6 Entry forms must be lodged with the relevant category manager with the entry fee. If entry forms are not completed correctly, they will be returned and entry will not be accepted until received back by the relevant category manager.

1.6 MEETINGS

- 1.6.1 **Round 1 – 2008 Australian Formula 3 Championship:**
For cars complying with the technical and sporting regulations for the 2008 Australian Formula 3 Championship.
2 x 13 lap races.
- 1.6.2 **Round 1 – 2008 Australian GT Championship:**
For cars complying with the technical and sporting regulations for the 2008 Australian GT Championship.
2 x 12 lap races and 1 x 17 lap race.

1.6.3 Historic Sports and Racing Cars:

For cars complying with the technical regulations for the 5th Category Historic Cars, Section 3.2 – Historic Sports and Racing Cars Groups Q, and R as per the 2008 CAMS Manual.

2 x 10 lap races and 1 x 5 lap race.

1.6.4 Prizes and Awards:

For all categories will be advised in the **Further Supplementary Regulations**.

1.7 PROGRAM

1.7.1 The meeting program will be included with the **Further Supplementary Regulations**.

1.7.2 The program may be varied or altered at the promoter's discretion to ensure the A1GP World Cup of Motorsport content stays on schedule. We do not anticipate any problems but it may be necessary to vary the program at any time. You will be notified of any change as soon as possible and the organisers will do everything possible to maintain your involvement as an important part of the program.

1.8 LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

1.8.1 Competitors must be the holders of a National Circuit Licence acceptable to CAMS.

1.8.2 Drivers must be the holders of a National Circuit Licence acceptable to CAMS.

1.9 PRIVATE PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

1.9.1 There is NO Circuit availability for private practice.

1.10 AUTOMATIC TIMING

1.10.1 The organisers utilise an automatic timing system, which requires all cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter which, is the competitor's responsibility. Data 1 transmitters are available from;

1.11 GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION

1.11.1 Support paddock and pit lane allocation will be advised in the **Further Supplementary Regulations**, as negotiated with the promoter and the relevant category manager.

1.12 COMPETITION NUMBER DECALS

1.12.1 The organiser will supply competition decals, as per Schedule K Article 2, these decals will include the A1GP World Cup of Motorsport Logo and a meeting sponsor. The decal will have sufficient space for competitors to affix their own competition numbers. Note that the use of these decals is compulsory and is a condition of entry and no other sign, logos, markings etc may be placed on the decal.

1.13 A1GP WORLD CUP OF MOTORSPORT REGULATIONS

1.13.1 A1GP World Cup of Motorsport please refer to the supplementary and/or further regulations which are issued separately. If there is a conflict between the A1GP World Cup of Motorsport regulations and these support category supplementary

regulations the A1GP World Cup of Motorsport regulations will take priority.

1.14 CAMPING AND BBQs

1.14.1 No camping is allowed at Eastern Creek International Raceway.

1.14.2 No gas fired cooking is allowed in the paddock area.

1.15 TWO WHEELED VEHICLES

1.15.1 No two wheeled vehicles (motorised scooters or motorcycles) are permitted in the paddock area. The only exception is motorcycles and/or buggies used as event and official vehicles.
