
Travelling

From Munich central station:

S1 Munich central station direction Oberschleißheim. Trains leave every 20 minutes.

The Munich Olympic Regatta Course is situated at the connection point Oberschleißheim A 92 (see sketch).

At the traffic light you drive towards Dachau. After 300 m on the left hand side you see the entrance to the regatta course.



Sights of the City

Pinakothek of Modern Art





Accreditations

Each participant in the 2007 World Rowing Championships receives an individual accreditation card for passing the controlled entrances to the regatta course. Further accreditations necessary are for special areas such as the press centre and FISA offices.

The FISA sends the accreditation forms to the National associations. These are to be completely filled-out and returned to the FISA by the appointed date. Accreditation cards for entrance to the Olympic Regatta Course will be required after 22 August 2007.
