SUMMER LEARNING ACTIVITIES

Summer is an excellent time for students to apply what they learn in school to everyday life. Continuous learning and reinforcement of their knowledge will give students a better start for the next school year. To help students continue learning during summer vacation, provide parents with a list of learning opportunities they can engage in over the summer months. Modify the list to fit the appropriate age level.

Reading/Language Arts

- Check out books from the public library, attend story time, and enroll in summer reading programs.
- Set aside 15 minutes every day for family reading time.
- Write letters to relatives or friends.
- Keep a journal of activities. Include drawings, photos, and thoughts.
- Repair, assemble, or build something that requires following directions.
- Subscribe to magazines and newspapers.
- Purchase logic puzzle, crossword, or word search books.
- While on a walk, have children read signs.

Fine Arts

- Build a model plane or car or other craft project.
- Write and perform a play with neighborhood kids.
- Attend community plays and concerts.

Social Studies

- Visit museums, parks, aquariums, nature trails, and zoos.
- Research family genealogy.
- On vacation, pick up brochures and learn about a city's history and culture.
- Use events such as the Olympics to explore the cultures and customs of other countries.
- Make a map of your neighborhood.
- Use a map to plan a trip to teach about map reading, directions, distances, mileage, and schedules.
- Map the route to the grocery store and places you visit.

Life Skills

- Work on jigsaw puzzles.
- Research vacation spots, map the route, and write the Visitor's Bureaus for information.
- Use recipes to plan a meal to determine portions, amounts, and measurements.
- Play board games that use strategy or knowledge.
- Volunteer at the local hospital, animal shelter, community center, summer camp, daycare center, nursing home, or church.
- Help with household chores, neighbors' yard work, washing cars, or collecting mail for vacationing neighbors.

Math

- Bake cookies to study measuring and fractions. Double the recipe to figure out new measurements.
- Use coupons at the grocery store and have children calculate the final bill and expected change.
- Determine the area and perimeter of your house.
- Draw a floor plan of your house to scale.
- Give children an allowance and have them keep track of savings and expenditures. Open a bank account for them.
- Let them set prices and make change for a yard sale or lemonade stand.
- Calculate gas mileage on a trip.

Science

- Get two healthy plants. Water and care for one, but not the other. Note the effects.
- Gently clip a small piece of paper onto a large leaf. After a week, remove the paper and discuss what has happened.
- Have them care for a flower or vegetable garden. Discuss the importance of sun, weeding, pruning, watering, and fertilizer.
- Take a nature walk and observe rocks, animals, insects, and leaves.
- Using a graph, track the weather for a month and observe patterns.
- Participate in a local recycling program.
- Study the night sky and find well known constellations. §
