Find the funding Mr Tanner – babies need carers!

The Australian Breastfeeding Association calls on the Federal Government to put paid maternity leave back on the agenda.

'The workforce of tomorrow begins with the babies of today. All parents should have the right to provide their own care for their child without compromising their employment status and economic position. Parenting is not a lifestyle choice but a part of the normal lifecycle. Paid maternity leave provides societal recognition of the important work of parenting', said Margaret Grove, President of the Australian Breastfeeding Association.

The Australian Breastfeeding Association supports 6 months paid maternity leave for all women. This is based on research that shows paid maternity leave increases the initiation and the duration of breastfeeding. All international, national and state health authorities recommend the support and protection of breastfeeding. Employment protection for breastfeeding is paramount because of the increasing number of women returning to work and the negative impact that this has on breastfeeding duration. Early weaning is associated with increased risks of gastrointestinal and respiratory illnesses, obesity, diabetes, breast cancer and poorer cognitive development.

Ms Grove explains, 'Babies need sensitive nurturing and responsive care for normal growth and development. The task of raising a child is one of the most important roles in our community.'

'It is time for the Federal Government and Australians to recognise paid maternity leave as intrinsic to the health of the population both now and in the future. We can't afford not to have a system of paid maternity leave in Australia', Ms Grove said.
