CONDITIONS

1. The holder of this Approval shall comply with all the conditions of the requirements for the grant of approval and the requirements for the maintenance of approval, being conditions set out in the Civil Airworthiness Requirements (Mauritius) published by the Department of Civil Aviation and for the time being in force.
2. The Holder of this Approval shall comply with the terms of the Exposition submitted by him and approved by the Department of Civil Aviation.
3. Nominated persons and signatories acceptable to the Department are as listed in Airbus Maintenance Organisation Manual. These persons may negotiate directly with the Department of Civil Aviation on their appropriate subjects.
4. Other persons authorised to furnish reports and/or make certifications within the scope of their personal authorisation are defined in the Maintenance Organisation Manual.
5. The attention of the holder of this Approval is drawn to Articles 29 and 130 of the Civil Aviation Regulations. These articles specify the authority of Civil Aviation Officers to access and inspect hangars, workshops, and aircraft, and to obtain such records as required. Article 137 details offences in regards to obstruction or impediment of the Civil Aviation Officers in the exercise of their powers or in performance of their duties.
6. The Quality Manager of the Organisation that provides facilities required by the Civil Airworthiness Requirements for the repair, replacement, modification and inspection of aircraft, or such of its equipment as is necessary for the airworthiness of the aircraft, will be responsible for the coordination of all departments and the maintenance of airworthiness standards required by the Department of Civil Aviation.
