## FROM OCEAN TO AQUARIUM

Valued up to \$330 million per year the trade in live marine ornamental species is a global industry dealing in 1471 fish species, 140 species of coral and more than 500 species of invertebrates. Coral reefs are the most important source of these animals which are <u>collected and transported thousands of miles from reef to retail outlets</u>, mainly in the USA, Europe and to a lesser extent, Japan.
