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July 17, 2007

Hannibal Town Board mt July 17, 2007 with all members present at the town hall at 8:00 p.m.

Chairman Reckid Moore called the meeting to order and the pledge was said. Clarke read minutes from June. Bob Winter moved to accept and Bevrie Budin second. Carried.

Bill Muller wants to put an addition to existing house. He does not have plans ~~yet~~ approved yet.

When this is done permit can be written. Bob Winter moved to accept Bevrie Budin second. Approved

with plans for a garage. Had plans approved by Bob Negus. Bob Winter moved to accept this plan. Bevrie Budin second. Approved and permit was written.

Ron Heechuk had his permit approved by Negus and had the set back approved by Charlie & Debbie Ohman. Wants to be 10% from property line. Variance was granted. Bevrie Budin moved to accept variance and permit plans. Bob Winter second. Approved and permit was issued.

Steve Valbert wants to build on a garage to his house. Needs to have plans approved by Bob Negus and then permit can be issued.

Bob Winter moved to accept and Dick Moore second. Approved.

Jack Gust wants to put up a pole shed on his property. Needs plans to be approved by Bob Negus and then permit can be issued. Bevrie Budin moved to accept and Bob Winter second. Approved.

Brian O'Connell & Joe ~~Wlynko~~ ^{Wlynko} from Northfield City Council came to explain some of the plan for property they are seeking for Industrial park.

for Northfield. John Juhnke has 185 acres and Dale Saem has 262 acres. They have said if annexed all has to go. There is a piece of property owned by St. Olaf College that is between hospital & land that is being considered. Cannot keep property for annexation. Taxes would stay up until such time as some plan would come forth. Present owners would keep farming also. There is not any plans done and no agreements done. We would need to get a lawyer to help draw up an agreement.

Victor Valbuts has a plat agreement drawn up for Loren Flidger property for 2 lots 8.47 acres and 6.78 acres to sell for building sites. Bob Winter moved to accept and Bernd Budde's second Agreement was signed & Victor will file with Nobata County.

David Legnall had a presentation prepared for Town hall to view on new Town Hall proposals. Greg Lauer, Wayne Letton & Eric Christensen were in attendance. They have narrowed down sites to one located on Jim Mulligan farm on Glen Ave. It con-

sests of 10 acres. Room for expansion if needed later. Building - Septic & well, an amount of \$250,000 was estimated. Many things play into this amount. Could use holding tank - not a septic system & such. Just a proposal this will be shown at the continuation of Annual meeting on July 24.

Doug Kilmeyer was present asking if gravel was satisfactory and if we need more loads he will put them on. Board was satisfied at this time. About 140 loads were put on in various spots.

Bernard Buden brought up about putting more tile in roads maybe on Eveleth. He will check with Dale Malecha if he is going to be in the area sometime. Jamaica was done last year on South end.

John Kuypers came before the board with an issue regarding his driveway. His land doesn't go to the road now since land is being split up. Bob Weiler told him they cannot land lock him as easement has to be issued. No one from Kuypers estate come to the meeting. Land is being sold. Not final yet.

John Duddley from Waterford gave click

a proposal for resurfacing Dresden
Road. \$20,000 was done by Baygan
and that is all we have. Suggested if
we do this this year has to be done
soon, so it sets up before Winter.
Board discussed and decided to ~~post~~^{look} off
until next year.

Otte Excavating (Jason & Bryce) were
in attendance & wondering if we had
any projects for them. Bridge on
Evelyn by Volkerts had not been
done very well after a piece of
farm equipment hit it last year. Ottie
said they would check & repair. Also
trees on 200th by lace & Baygan could
use some bushing. Ottie will give us
a bid next meeting and suggestions
how to handle this. Bushing - sawing
spraying - etc. Will check with Landowner
if big trees hanging over road.

Clerk asked if we could appoint
Deputy Clerk & Treasurer. Richard
Moore moved this be done. Bob Weater
seconded. Can be from out of township also.
Need a double arrow sign on Jamaica
and 205th will add 2 so we
have a spare one.

Bills were acted on and paid.
