

The Greenville Town Board ~~met~~^{met} on Feb 19, 2008 at the town hall with all town Board members present except Barb Minar, at 8:00 P.M.

Chairman Richard Moore called the meeting to order and the pledge was said.

Clerk proceeded to read the minutes for January. Bob Wente moved to accept. Bernard Budin second approved.
