MDSHIPMAN stalked the pace outside, ranged up four wide into the stretch, gained the lead under some left handed urging four wide past the eighth pole and inched clear. STREET HERO bumped and forced in at the start, stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn to put a head in front, dueled along the fence, fought back in the stretch and held second. OYSTER CAT had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail, continued toward the inside in the stretch and edged a rival for third. FITZMO threw his head slightly but broke alertly, dueled outside on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, re-bid three deep between foes into the stretch and until just midstretch and weakened some but was edged late for the show. NOCHANGENWEATHER settled off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position. LAUNCH THE BULL had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, fought back between horses into the stretch and until past midstretch and weakened. RAIKKONEN broke a bit slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. SMOKEY DEHERE broke a bit in the air and slowly, settled off the rail on the backstretch and turn and failed to menace. INVISIBLE EDGE chased outside a rival then inside on the turn and in the stretch and weakened.
