1 1/4 MILES. (1.473) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *HOLY BULL S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$150 each by Saturday, January 17, 2009, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made on Wednesday, January 28, 2009 at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded/group sweepstakes, allowed, 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over, 6 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming at any distance, 8 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Horses finishing first, second or third in the Holy Bull will automatically be nominated to the Florida Derby. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with AlsoEl igibles. High Weights Preferred with second preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed February 7, 2009 with 23 nominations. (Clear 65)

SARATOGA SINNER chased BEAR'S ROCKET off the rail into the stretch, rallied to catch that rival at the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. BEAR'S ROCKET quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail into the stretch, responded when headed by SARATOGA SINNER at the eighth pole and held on well for the place while being edged to the wire. WEST SIDE BERNIE unhurried early, circled rivals four wide to loom a threat racing into the stretch but couldn't gain late. BEETHOVEN chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then gave way. STATELY CHARACTER outrun after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals. BRUCE N AUTUMN stalked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. DANGER TO SOCIETY well placed racing off the rail, had no response when asked on the far turn and faltered. ROCKLAND was outrun. EL CRESPO was no factor while racing three wide. IDOL MAKER stalked the pace four wide into the far turn, then faded.
