Closed with 7. \$2,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. All Early Bird nominees to the 2009 Santa Anita Derby (Closing Date, Monday, December 15, 2008 - Closed with 173.) are automatically eligible to the Robert B. Lewis Stakes with all fees waived. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 at one mile or over since Aug ust 1, 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; \$100,000 at any distance since September 1, 2007, 5 lbs.; of \$25,000 at one mile or over or \$30,000 at any distance, 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. e of horses with equal weights. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) PIONEEROF THE NILE settled off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied under a couple cracks of the whip and energetic handling to get up late. PAPA CLEM stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses leaving the second turn, battled off the rail in the stretch, gained the advantage past midstretch, inched away late but could not hold off the winner. I WANT REVENGE close up stalking the pace off the inside then outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead, battled outside the runner-up in the drive and held third. BITTEL ROAD chased inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for the show. MARK S THE COOLER settled just off the inside then along the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OIL MAN (IRE) settled off the pace outside a rival, went three deep into and out of the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. BROTHER KEITH sped to the early lead outside foes, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. SHAFTED broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. CHARLIE'S MOMENT three deep early, chased outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and gave way.
