(GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$200 each (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed). \$1,000 to enter; \$1,250 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$200,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 11% to third; 6% to fourth; and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000, allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000, 4 lbs.; \$20,000, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Preference to horses according to highest lifetime earnings excluding restricted races at the time of passing entry box. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed Saturday, January 24, 2009, with 8 nominations (plus 9 4 Early Bird Nominations). FRIESAN FIRE close up from early on, raced between foes until nearing the drive, angled out to bid, gained the edge outside FLYING PEGASUS inside the furlong marker and proved clearly best. FLYING PEGASUS five wide around the first turn, raced four wide down the backstretch, came three wide around the second turn, gained the edge entering the drive, gained the edge and then held second. UNO MAS unhurried early, settled off the rail down the backstretch, moved up four wide around the second turn, loomed a threat, then had no final kick. NOWHERE TO HIDE raced inside and lacked a late response. GIANT OAK off last, crossed to the inside going to the first turn, raced between foes in the run down the backstretch, lacked room midway around the second turn, was steered out after entering the drive and made a late gain. SOUL WARRIOR devoid speed, moved to the inside around the first turn, eased out in the drive and improved position. INDYGO MOUNTAIN reserved early, moved up nearing the turn, eased out and then could make little impact. AU MOON showed little. DUMAR raced wide. IT HAPPENED AGAIN set the pace to the drive, then stopped. MAP OF THE WORLD raced inside and was outrun. SUMMER'S EMPIRE was never dangerous. CODE OF HONOUR prompted the pace to the drive, then gave way.
