The Administrator has prepared tentative determinations regarding the operating permits that, in brief, affect the following sources: ore roasters, ore dryers, ore pre-heaters, calcine quench circuits, autoclaves, carbon kilns, retorts, melt furnaces, electrowinning systems, pregnant tanks, barren tanks and drying ovens.

The tentative Phase-1 Mercury Operating Permits to Construct activities include monitoring, recordkeeping, annual stack testing for mercury emissions, annual emissions reporting, annual mercury co-product reporting, limits of operation and work practice standards which minimize emissions of mercury to the atmosphere. Other tentative permit contents include Presumptive NvMACT status pursuant to NAC 445B.3651 & 445B.3653 and Early Reduction Credit project status.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS and the NAC, the Administrator is hereby announcing his intent to issue Phase-1 Mercury Operating Permits to Construct based on review of the information, as proposed.
