## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION Web posting 4/28/09

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for renewal of water pollution control effluent reuse discharge permit (NEV99003) from the applicant:

Las Vegas Golf I, LLC dba Angel Park Golf Club 241 S. Rampart Boulevard Las Vegas, Nevada 89145

The applicant proposes to continue reuse irrigation at the Angel Park Golf Club Golf Courses at 241 S. Rampart Boulevard in northwest Las Vegas. The applicant utilizes tertiary treated, nitrified, and disinfected effluent for irrigation of turf grasses and landscaped areas of both the Palm Golf Course and the Mountain Golf Courses of Angel Park. Reclaimed (reuse) water is supplied by the Northwest Water Resource Center. Reuse irrigation is conducted in accordance with an approved Effluent Management Plan and terms and conditions of the permit. Monitoring will be required. The permit renewal will be issued for a five (5) year period.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue a permit to discharge, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, either in person, by mail or FAX (775) 687.4684 by June 1, 2009, to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day comment period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the applications. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permits, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public

notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date. If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
