# **4<sup>TH</sup> NEC MKMVA MEETING**

### 28-30 October 2013

#### REPORT OF THE GENERAL SECRETARY

- 1. **INTRODUCTION**: It is over a year since the current MKMVA was elected at Birchwood Hotel in the 4<sup>th</sup> MKMVA Conference held from 11`to 14 October 2012. In that regard it perhaps important to look into the tasks we set ourselves and some developments that played a positive or negative role in our path. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> NEC Meeting of the NEC held at Boyesens Hotel, Johannesburg, we resolved to focus on three tasks for the term of the current NEC namely: Welfare (including training and employment); Political Education; and Organisational Development. This report tries to focus on these three areas of work and other developments such as the Gauteng issue and the formation of the new SANMVA as the "umbrella body" of military veterans as stated in the Military Veterans Act No. 18 of 2011. Members are encouraged to add issues to the agenda before its adoption so that they are discussed. Let us emerge from this 4<sup>th</sup> NEC Meeting more united and ready for tasks ahead, especially assisting the ANC win a 2/3 majority in the 2014 National Elections.
- 2. **AREAS OF WORK**: In the 3<sup>rd</sup> NEC report we noted the following regarding the question of areas of work:

- (ii) WORKSHOPS: Conducting workshops on welfare benefits with DMV in terms of the *Military Veterans' Act No 18* of 2011. These are concurrently happening with the issuing of Medical Cards programme to all qualifying Military Veterans in ALL 9 Provinces. Cde. Nonkonzo MOLAI to add more to this in her presentation .
- (iii) HOUSING: assess what type of a household does the veteran live in. Do they need a bigger and better house?
- (iv) EDUCATION & TRAINING: Conduct skills audit and need for what particular skilling or training or education is required by whom in the Veteran's Household
- (v) HEALTH CARE: Does the veterans have Medical Aid Card/Health Card? Does he/she suffer from any chronic illness including HIV/AIDS; TB etc? Access to health care facilities-GOOD/BAD?
- (vi) COUNSELLING: Does any member of the family need form of counselling? Who can provide this professional service?
- (vii) PENSIONS/SOCIAL GRANTS: Does the veteran and family get any pension or social grants they deserve? Is DISABILITY catered for? Is assessment accurate?
- (viii) EMPLOYMENT: Is the veteran employed? What needs to be done assist the veteran get employment or self-employment?
- (ix) What improvement/s can be made for uplifting the veteran/s' lifestyle?

**Note Well:** The above areas of work and questions need to be answered honestly and earnestly if we mean dealing with Welfare problems; Political Education; and Organisational Development.

- 3. **FINANCE:** In order to achieve the above objectives, MKMVA needs MONEY. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> NEC of 3-5 May 2013, the Chairperson and Treasurer General promised to provide R10 million to assist MKMVA with its operational work. Some shares were going to be sold and money transferred to MKMVA. This was very seriously welcome as the ANC is struggling in this area. At the moment **MKMVA** has **NO BANK BALANCE LET ALONE A BANK ACCOUNT!** The Chairperson and the Treasurer General have to explain to the NEC on progress as June 2013 as the DEADLINE for the transfer of these funds has long gone! (Refer to Minutes of NEC Meeting of 3-5 May 2013)
- 4. SANMVA CONFERENCE: 28 September to 2 October 2013: Although billed to end on 01 October, this Conference was extended by the one day. MKMVA aims dominating this structure, but is this practical or just a wish? The results came out as follows:

In the top six (NOB) there are two against four and in additional members there are 09 against 11. First question is: Will MKMVA dominate SANMVA? And two; why did Cde. Tshidiso PAKA (223) win against Dudu PHAMA (208) by 15 votes? Did our strategic approach to these elections work? What are the lessons for the future? Why the Court Case? And, how do we make SANMVA/DMV work for MKMVA members?

GAUTENG MATTER: As stated by the General Secretary in MKMVA NEC with the Minister of Defence and Military Veterans, we cannot talk the UNITY OF MKMVA with the Gauteng Province Executive Committee disbanded and the investigation instituted by the Office of the Secretary General/Peace and Stability Committee dragging on inconclusively. The General Secretary has spoken to the Chief Investigating officer, Cde. Billy Lesedi MASETLHA about this issue and they were both of the feeling that this should be resolved soon so that the entire MKMVA can focus on the 2014 General Elections work. The modus operandi proposed is that the NOB and POB of Gauteng Province meet

in his presence and have issues thrashed out, because are not bigger than business of the ANC in the current period: to win the 2014 General Elections!
